



Missed Eureka? Just realizing your leadership potential? The California Library Association is accepting applications for a series of leadership workshops in early 2018. A cohort of 15 people will be selected to attend all 3 workshops with financial and have access to additional learning resources. They will be expected to participate in additional interviews and/or surveys to help evaluate the project. Additional spaces for each workshop will be opened for registration on a first-come, first-served basis once the cohort is selected. This application is ONLY for those interested in joining the cohort.

The opportunity: Building on a successful 2016-17 year that included the development of a statewide vision for library leadership and delivery of several regional institutes, CLA received funding from the California State Library this year to create regional workshops based on a national leadership curriculum for libraries, archives and museums.

As a member of the cohort, you will participate in three half-day afternoon workshops:

- January 18 in Mission Viejo on the theme of innovation and creativity
- February 15 in Fresno on the theme of motivating change
- March 8 in Sacramento on the theme of engaging diverse groups to lead change

These workshops will be led by experienced facilitators, and during and after the sessions, you will be able to engage with your cohort to develop your skills and network. A stipend of up to \$300 per workshop will cover travel expenses. Additional funds may be available for rural library staff.

Minimum qualifications: Applicants must be residents of California and must either be employed in a California library of any type or enrolled in a library-related degree program. If employed, the head of your library must sign to indicate your ability to attend. Commitment to attend all three sessions is required. Any expenses beyond the stipend are the responsibility of the attendee.
